## **WATER AND SEWER FEES**

### **Sewers**

Permit \$50

In addition to any other fees or charges provided by law, the owner of any parcel of real property served by the sewer system, including but not limited to real property connected with the sewer system by means of a private sewer or drain emptying into the sewer system, shall pay a sewer rent. Such rent is hereby fixed at an amount equal to 40% of the charge now made or hereafter made for the water supplied to any such real property.
