

## **Traffic Safety Committee**

June 23, 2015

The Traffic Safety Committee met at 8:30 a.m. on Tuesday, June 23, 2015 in the classroom located on the lower level of the Municipal Center. The meeting commenced with Chairman John Stella, Street Superintendent Anthony “Zep” Thomaselli, Police Chief Doug Solomon, Fire Chief Gary VanVoorhis and Planning Board Representative Gary Barrack in attendance.

### **New Business**

Churchill Street / Creek Drive Development (Planning Board) – The committee briefly discussed the traffic flow on Churchill Street. One suggestion would be to turn Churchill Street into a one-way another was to grade the road from the railroad tracks up to Main Street so the incline to get onto Main Street is not so steep. The committee felt this is little premature they would like more information so they can examine traffic flow and safety.

Mr. Stella would like the Traffic Safety Committee to be placed on Planning Board distribution list so they will receive copies of the agendas and minutes. The committee would like the copies of the agendas this way they know what is coming through and would like to weigh in on the larger projects.

### **Old Business**

Discussion took place with regard to Scenic Hudson’s Gateway to Mt. Beacon Park due to parking lot overflow onto Howland Avenue and Exeter Circle. Police Chief Solomon and Fire Chief VanVoorhis passed through over the weekend and noticed most vehicles were parked on Howland Avenue rather than Exeter Circle. It was also suggested that Scenic Hudson put a sign up in the park that says “Do Not Park on Exeter Circle”.

Mr. Stella suggested the Committee switch to a summer schedule, and will not meet in July or August. The next meeting will be held on September 29, 2015 at 8:30 a.m.
